Yard Waste

Collection Procedures

December 1st thru August 31

1. organic materials will be accepted. This includes grass, leaves, hedge trimmings, and sticks.
2. All grass, leaves, and trimmings should be placed in bio-degradable bags or containers with lids and placed at the curb. (Not exceeding 35 lbs.)
3. All sticks must be under 1 inch in diameter and less than 4 feet in length. They must be tied in bundles weighing less than 35 lbs. Larger branches or shrubbery will be pick-up for a fee.
4. Brush or shrubbery will be charged at \$25.00 per small dump truck load.
5. All requests for pick-up must be made before noon on Thursdays to be picked up on Fridays.
6. You may call City Hall at 472-1651 to request a pick-up. You may request to be placed on a bi-weekly pick-up list. This list will be renewed in March of each year.

Yard debris collection will be conducted on the first and third Friday of every month.

Yard Waste

Collection Procedures

September 1st thru November 30th

1. Only organic materials will be accepted. This includes grass, leaves, hedge trimmings, and sticks.
2. All grass, leaves, and trimmings should be placed in bags or containers with lids and placed at the curb. (Not exceeding 35 lbs.)
3. All sticks must be under 1 inch in diameter and less than 4 feet in length. They must be tied in bundles weighing less than 35 lbs. Larger branches or shrubbery will be pick-up for a fee.
4. Brush or shrubbery will be charged at \$25.00 per small dump truck load.
5. All requests for pick-up must be made before noon on Thursdays to be picked up on Fridays.
6. You may call City Hall at 472-1651 to request a pick-up.
7. Yard debris collection will be conducted every Friday.
