

# BUCKHANNON CITY POLICE VOLUNTEERS IN POLICE SERVICE (VIPS) PROGRAM 2019 ANNUAL REPORT



### • Organization's fifth year anniversary

- o The first VIPS meeting was held October 23, 2014
- VIPS has grown exponentially in the past five years.
- Our five-year press release is included on pages 3 and 4.

### Hours Volunteered

- o In addition to assisting with the previously listed events, VIPS members also assisted the department with administrative tasks, business security checks and by performing ride alongs with officers.
- VIPS volunteered over 3130 hours during 2019, allowing officers to tend to other situations during those hours and potentially saving the city almost \$70,000.00 in labor.
- o Several members are college students, and their activity is directly related to their college class schedule.
- o The attached chart on page 2 breaks down VIPS 2019 hours by month and member.

### Membership and training

- VIPS began 2019 with twelve active members, and during the year deactivated nine members due to relocation, graduation, pursuing other interests, or ineligibility.
- We trained ten new members during the year to end 2019 with 11 active and two inactive members.
- o We have enhanced our member training to align with CALEA and FEMA / NIMS
- Our training now covers ethics, basic medical, basic search and rescue, basic fire suppression, traffic and crowd management, basic and advanced disaster / MCI management, as well as other topics and skills.

The Buckhannon City Police Volunteers In Police Service (VIPS) unit celebrated its fifth anniversary October 23, 2019. Although we have been around for five years, you still may not be familiar with our program.

Our VIPS program allows community members to volunteer their time by assisting our city police officers with various tasks. We assist with traffic and crowd management for events, emergency traffic control, missing persons searches, perimeter security for incidents,

public relations in the community and schools, investigations, and other administrative tasks. Our ability to help with these tasks allows the officers to concentrate on more immediate and emergent situations.

All our VIPS members receive training through the police department such as: First Aid / CPR / AED, Community Emergency Response Training (CERT), Citizens Police Academy, Traffic and Crowd Management, Ethics, and various National Incident Management System (NIMS) courses offered through FEMA (Federal Emergency Management Administration). These required training courses are all taught in house with our own instructors.

Over the past five years, VIPS members have volunteered more than 7500 hours and helped with over 500 events in our area! We have welcomed over 40 community members and college students into our VIPS program since 2014, with 12 volunteers currently active. We even have three of the original five founding members still actively volunteering with VIPS!

Interested in becoming a VIPS member? There are a few requirements you will need to meet prior to submitting an application. Are you:

- 1. Over the age of 18?
- 2. Able to pass a background check?
- 3. Willing to volunteer at least eight (8) hours per month?
- 4. Willing to attend at least one (1) meeting per month?
- 5. Willing to help better our community?
- 6. Willing to wear a cool uniform?

If you can answer yes to all these questions, we would love to have you in the VIPS program. Presidential recognition sets you apart from your peers. It is a tremendous honor. Even though you may not seek recognition, your example can deliver a powerful message that encourages others to take action.

The President's Volunteer Service Award recognizes United States citizens and lawfully admitted, permanent residents of the United States who have achieved the required number of hours of service over a 12-month time period or cumulative hours over the course of a lifetime.

### **How it Works**

### Criteria

Individuals, families and groups that meet the criteria are eligible for the PVSA.

- Recipient(s) must be a United States citizen or a lawfully admitted permanent resident of the United States.
- Awards are issued for service hours served within a 12-month time period or over the course of a lifetime.
- Awards are issued for volunteer service only; additional levels of participation with the organization (i.e., charitable support) are not a factor considered for the award.
- Court-ordered community service does not qualify for the award.

- Awards are issued by approved Certifying Organizations.
- Service must be with an approved Certifying Organization that is legally established in the United States, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico or one of the U.S. territories.

### Eligibility

Hours are measured over a 12-month period and awards are designated based on cumulative hours. The awards are offered in multiple levels and are designed to recognize each milestone of your service achievement. Levels include bronze, silver, gold and the highest honor, the President's Lifetime Achievement Award for those who contribute more than 4,000 hours of service in their lifetime.
