- **A. Call to Order** The meeting was called to order by Mayor Skinner.
 - **A.1 Moment of Silence** The Mayor asked for all to join him in a Moment of Silence.
 - **A.2** Pledge to the Flag of the United States of America The Pledge was led by Mayor Skinner.

B. Recognized Guests:

B.1 Don Nestor - Alliance between UCBOE & SYCC - The Mayor recognized Don Nestor who provided an update on the meetings that have been going on between the UCBOE & SYCC. One of the specifics that they talked about was what to call their group and a suggestion had been made to call it the

Stockert Youth and Community Coalition. Both Don Nestor and Debora Brockleman felt that they needed to bring this back to the SYCC Board for their thoughts on the name. He further reported on the amount of activity that has been ongoing and the various contributions the different entities have been making. One idea is to use someone from Fred W Eberle Technical Center to provide training with the use of the computers for both students and parents of SYCC students. He explained other opportunities of the multiagency collaboration including programs representing special needs individuals. The group has subcommittees set up and Community Care is dedicated to hiring a fulltime person who will provide 20 hours per week to this specific coalition moving the ideas they have forward. Debora Brockleman explained some of the duties of the person that Community Care will hire, and none will conflict with what SYCC personnel are currently doing.

Regarding the proposed name, Stockert Youth and Community Coalition, Board member Nolte felt that the meetings have pulled in many more agencies beyond SYCC, and other members had concerns that the proposed name makes it sound like we oversee the group. Both Recorder Sanders and Mayor Skinner had concerns with the name being so close to that of Stockert Youth and Community Center that it will be a public relations problem. It was the general consensus of the Board to not go along with the proposed name.

Without objection, the Mayor moved G.3 Continued Discussion Concerning an Additional Alliance between UCBOE & SYCC.

The Mayor asked if it was the will of the Board for Don Nestor and Debora Brockleman to continue representing SYCC in the meetings to see where the work with the coalition could take the community.

We have a full schedule of activities planned for the next few weeks including swimming at UC pool, field trip to the Wildlife Center, walking tours around town visiting the courthouse, a bank, the fire dept., the State Equipment division, the post office, Fox's pizza, the library and various other places around our town.

Summer Basketball

Pony Basketball began last week for grades 3^{rd} - 12^{th} . We are using our outdoor court in the evenings Monday/Wed/Friday. Our Basketball Clinic for K- 2^{nd} starts tonight and will run for this week only Monday-Friday

Summer Volleyball

We are hoping to start soon. Signups for teams have been slow so we need to advertise again and get things going in July.

Collaboration with BOE

Don and I continue to meet with Board of Education members, School staff and community members to discuss and plan for ways to help students in whatever way we can. SYCC offers activities for all age groups. Beginning in the fall we hope to offer internships to students from FETC come to SYCC to help with technology in the after-school program. We are also planning a computer class for adults and for technical assistance with computer questions and issues.

New Hire

We have hired Amber Diffenderfer as our Administrative Staff Assistant. She will be doing billing for the afterschool and summer camp as well as deposits, day to day office duties and program assistance.

We have several new part time folks for summer camp which all have had background checks and drug tests before beginning work. They each attended staff training last Thursday before beginning the start of Camp Buccaneer today.
