- The Captain is responsible for administration, supervision and management of the Fire Department. The Captain is assigned to a 24 hour shift or an operational period or training evolution that is responsible for fire suppression, hazardous material response, rescue operations and emergency medical services.

- Minimum $10\ \text{years}$ of service at the Buckhannon Fire Department
- All the following training must be West Virginia approved, Pro Board, IFSAC certified training

- Performs duties serving as a confidential staff advisor to the Fire Chief in researching, crafting, implementing and enforcing policies, directives and procedures
- Implements department goals and objectives through a comprehensive administration program and coordinates department operations, inspections, maintenance and training under the direction of the Fire Chief.
- Performs the role of officer in charge of all fire, rescue and medical operations for assigned shift, Assumes the role of incident commander and determines an overall plan to resolve incidents until command is transferred. Directs subordinate members to appropriate assignments to ensure the plan of action is followed in a safe and efficient manner.
- Assists in long range planning and implementation of department budgets. Assists the Fire Chief in the planning process for capital projects
- Assists in the development of minimum standards of training and technical competence for all Fire Department personnel. Ensures the readiness of personnel and equipment under their supervision. Ensures the utilization of NIMS at emergency scenes.
