**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

SKID STEER AND BUCKET**

The Buckhannon Sanitary Board will accept sealed bids for a skid steer and bucket at City Hall at 70 East Main Street, Buckhannon, WV 26201 until 7:30 AM EST on November 18, 2021, at which time all bids which have been received shall be publicly opened and read aloud.

Minimum characteristics of the **SKID STEER** to be provided by this bid are as follows. A full list of required characteristics is attached.

- New skid steer loader of standard manufacture by the company represented by the vendor submitting the bid.
- Gross power shall be minimum of 74 HP
- The operating weight shall be 10,500 lbs and should not exceed 12,000 lbs.
- Machine shall be equipped with rubber tracks.
- The engine shall be a 3.3-liter, direct fuel injected, turbocharged, liquid cooled, and have 4 cylinders. The engine must meet Tier 4 Final and EU Stage V emissions standards.
- The machine shall have braided, color-coded and numbers wiring harness.
- Machine shall have a water-in-fuel sensor with an indicator in the cab.
- Two hydrostatic axial piston drive pumps shall be splined directly to the engine.
- 2 speed must be standard and shall have planetary gear reduction final drive.
- Machine shall be equipped with a single, electrically operated joystick which controls the forward and reverse steering directions.
- Machine shall have spring be equipped with a single, electrically operated joystick which controls lift, lower, and tilt.
- Machine shall have a rear-view camera.

Characteristics of the **BUCKET** to be provided by this bid are as follows.

- Minimum bucket width to be no less than 80 inches.
- Have a bolt on cutting edge.

Bidder must provide the following items.

- Must provide documented 3 years of reputable sales and service, prior to bid.
- Combined bid price of skid steer and bucket delivered to Buckhannon Sewer Plant. Bid sheet shall include specific identification of the equipment to include: 1) vendor, 2) manufacturer, 3) model, 4) year, and 5) list of special features. Bid sheet is to be signed by an authorized representative of the vendor.
- Availability of skid steer and bucket to include a delivery date if ordered by December 2nd, 2021.
- Product literature including basic specifications of the model skid steer being offered.
- Vendor financing available, including interest rate, monthly payment, and total cumulative payment for vendor financing over a 60-month term.
- Equipment warranty. Include calendar time, operating time, and components covered by warranty.
- Location of and distance from Buckhannon of closest full-service sales, parts, and service center for equipment manufacturer.
- Name, location, and telephone number of three customers in West Virginia who have recently purchased a similar piece of equipment.

E.1 33 West Extension North – JF Allen Co - The Sanitary Department has made the taps to H2 Group and Smitty’s Suzuki. Ethan attached letters to send to the customers notifying them.

Dear Customer,

During the past 2 years the City of Buckhannon had the opportunity to extend its sewage collection system to your area. This provides a great resource for your business and property. Having sewage treated at a plant has several benefits over a private septic system, a few include:

- The city is responsible for maintenance of their lines. We have experienced and knowledgeable employees to keep the system functioning properly.
- When a septic system fails, it is costly, having city sewer will save money in the long run.
- No pumping or maintenance of septic tanks.

Unfortunately extending the sewer system is costly. The City of Buckhannon Sanitary Board was able to give \$100,000.00 towards the construction of this project, which is about 1/3 the project cost. Since the sewer is now available, the City of Buckhannon is charging the fees adopted in City Ordinance 449, (attached) in order to recover the money invested into this extension. These fees are covered in one of two options:

- A one-time payment of \$16,222.00.
- A monthly payment of \$50.00 per month for approximately 324 months.

E.3 Plant Operations - The tests have all been within limits. The crews have cleaned out the sludge storage/drying beds so they can accurately monitor the amount of sludge being produced and disposed of each month. The NPDES Permit is just about finished.

The board reviewed and approved the previous month's credit memos. No shutoffs this month.

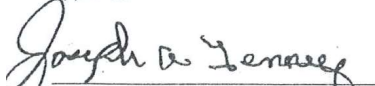

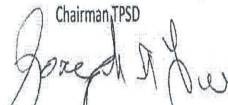
Upshur County Commission

Motion to approve the Minutes from 10/21/21 was made by Frye/Loftis. Motion carried.

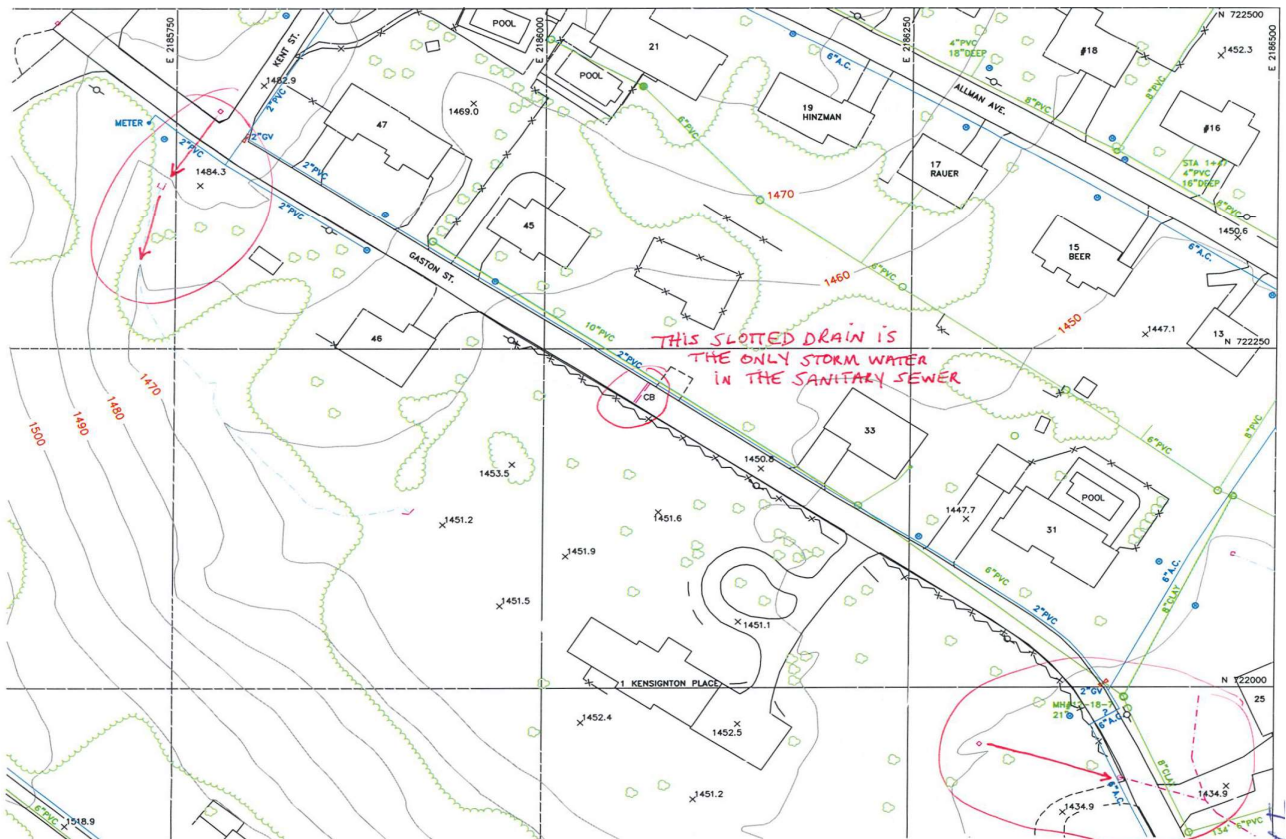
I. Strategic Issues for Discussion and/or Vote

I.1 Skid Steer Bid Opening/Request to change – Mayor Skinner recognized Ethan Crosten who noted that last month the department requested to buy a skid steer. The lines crews came to him and suggested that a mini track hoe would be more beneficial to the department. Looking at the long-term goals of the department Ethan has begun to agree with this recommendation. As the on-call engineering services begin to handle the larger projects, with less earth needing moved, a skid steer would not be as beneficial. With the bigger jobs handled, we would be doing more taps and smaller jobs, something a mini track hoe would be a huge help with. We have rented one several times in the recent past and the need for it will continue to grow. It is approximately the same price as a new skid steer. Gene Frye and Jerry Arnold both agreed that a mini track hoe would be more useful for the department.

Motion to rescind the earlier motion made under line item C that stated “Motion to accept the bid from Leslie Equipment Company for a John Deere Skid Steer Track Loader & Bucket, provided all bid specifications were met, at a bid price of \$61,750 was made by Frye/Loftis. Motion carried.” was made by Frye/Loftis. Motion carried.

Motion to advertise for bids on a Mini Track Hoe was made by Frye/Loftis. Discussion: Mr. Loftis recommended that we reject all bids under line item C, which was agreed to by the Board. Motion carried.

I.2 Gaston Street Storm Update - As requested at the last meeting, more investigation work has been done on the Gaston Street area. It appears that the slotted drain is the only source of inflow. A discussion with the Board took place regarding the results of the investigation. Ethan stated that we could look further into tying the slotted drain into the existing storm water drainage system. Jerry Arnold asked that he look into that solution, including whether or not that existing storm water drainage system would need to be upgraded, and report back at a future meeting.

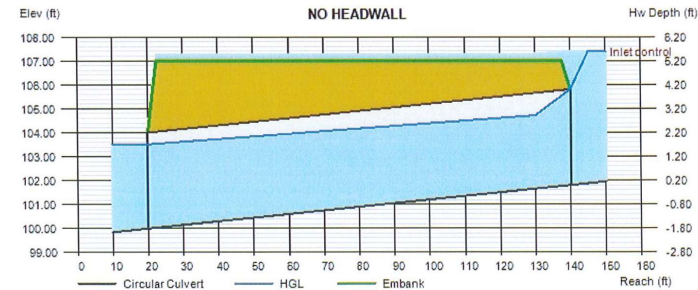

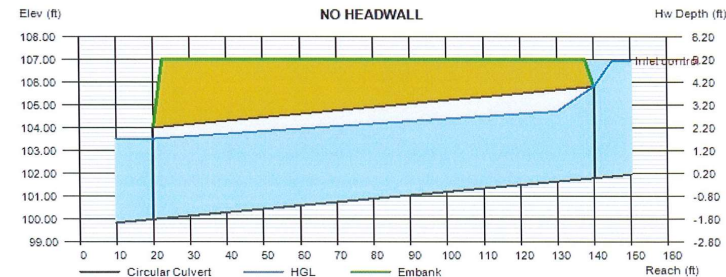

I.4 Whistle Stop Grease Issues – Discussion on this issue took place and it was explained that employees were dumping cooking grease into drop inlet near their building. Jerry has informed Ethan that he has cited the Whistle Stop for this already and is watching them closely. The Mayor asked that we get a copy of the recent citation.

I.5 Plant Phone System Update – Mr. Crosten reported that Sunday, November 8 all of the department phones quit working but one at the plant. From talking to employees, the current phone system is at least 12 years old and they have been having trouble with them for some time. Tate Communications gave an estimate of \$5,314.42 for a new complete system, installed. This system would also allow the department to be connected to City Hall.

Motion to approve the purchase of the Univerge SV9100 Communication Server System, as described in the estimate of November 16, 2021, from Tate Communications for a total of \$5,314.42 was made by Frye/Loftis. Motion carried.

I.6 Plan of Action Comments – Mayor Skinner asked the Board if they have reviewed the Plan of Action submitted by Superintendent Crosten and if they have any comments. Mr. Frye noted that he was comfortable with the Plan as presented. Mr. Loftis was concerned about a section in the plan that would eliminate one crew in the future. It was determined that we table the discussion until the next meeting. All agreed.

I.7 Discussion/Vote Compensation for Sanitary Supervisor - Mayor Skinner recommended that we increase Superintendent Ethan Crosten’s salary to \$55,000 per year.

Motion to increase Ethan Crosten’s salary to \$55,000 per year was made by Frye/Loftis. Motion carried.

- **Board Member Loftis** – Mr. Loftis asked about a \$14,000 Storm Water expense and what is was for. Mr. Crosten and Amby noted is was for the Spring Street project.
- **Jerry Arnold** – Jerry Arnold is okay with the \$55,000 salary for now but he felt that we should provide the following incentives: Ethan should work to obtain his Fundamentals of Engineering (EI classification – Engineering Intern) and we then provide him an increase in pay, amount to be determined at that time; then within a 5 to 6 year period expect Ethan to obtain his PE (Professional Engineering) degree, which will change his classification to an Engineer and then we provide an additional increase, amount to be determined at that time. All Board members agreed to this incentive program.
