Chief Gregory explained that one candidate is currently on the eligibility list.

Currently there are no vacancies to fill, however, the Commission is required to establish an eligibility list.

Motion Spencer/Kolenich to Begin the Process to Replenish the Probationary Police Officer Eligibility List. Motion carried.

The following dates were established for the process:

- Applications will be accepted until September 9, 2022.
- Applications will be reviewed by the Police Civil Service Commission on September 14, 2022 at 6:00 pm.
- Physical Agility and the Written Test will be held October 1, 2022. The Physical Agility Test will be held at 10:00 am and the Written Test will be held at 1:00 pm at the Public Safety Complex.

Chief Gregory commented that the notary affidavit is not necessary and deters applicants from applying.

Motion was made by Spencer/Kolenich to Remove the need of a Notary Affidavit from the Application Packet. Motion carried.

Chief Gregory reminded Commission members that the current candidate on the eligibility list will be given the option to better his score if he chooses. However, if he decides to retake the test, that score will replace the current score.

There was a brief conversation to confirm that candidates will not be given the option of making up or rescheduling their physical agility or written tests. Giving candidates this option becomes too subjective and there are no guidelines in place to allow for this in the rules.
